Recipes



Dirt Cups

2 cups Milk
1 package Instant Chocolate Pudding
3 1/2 cups Cool Whip
16 ounces Oreos, crushed
Gummy Worms
White wafer cookies (like Milanos)
Black decorating icing
8 ounce clear plastic cups

Make the pudding according to the package directions and let set in the refrigerator for about 10 minutes.

Stir the pudding, cool whip and half of the cookies together in a small bowl.

Put 1 tablespoon of crushed cookies in the bottom of a clear plastic cup. Fill cup about 3/4 full with pudding mixture. Top with remaining crumbs.

To make the tombstones, cut the wafer cookies in half. Write RIP on the top with the black decorating icing. Decorate the cups with gummy worms and tombstones.



Spiders

1 (12 ounce) package

1 (5 ounce) can

Decorating candy

Semi-sweet chocolate chips

La Choy chow mein noodles

Melt the chocolate chips in the microwave for 1 minute. Stir, then microwave again in 20 sec. intervals until completely melted.

Stir in enough Chow Mein noodles until they are covered with the chocolate. You may not need all of the noodles

Drop by spoonfuls onto waxed paper and form into spiders. Add decorating candy for spider eyes.

Note: You can add 2-4 tablespoons of water, if needed, to thin the melted chocolate chips.



Skeletons

White chocolate covered pretzels

Large marshmallows

Lollipop sticks or straws

Black decorating icing

White frosting

Flatten the marshmallow slightly. Press the stick or straw into the bottom of the marshmallow. Draw a skeleton face on the front of the marshmallow.

Slide on the pretzels and use a little frosting to hold the pretzels in place.

Break off little pieces of a few pretzels to make the arms. Attach them with a little frosting.



Flying Bats

Miniature peanut butter cups

Chocolate wafer cookies

Decorating candy or red or white decorating icing

Carefully cut a little slit in each side of the peanut butter cup. Break a wafer cookie in half and slide the end into the slit.

Decorate the top with candy or icing to make eyes.

Graveyard



For a party, combine all of the treats to create a graveyard. Put the dirt pudding in first, top with the crushed Oreos and then decorate with tombstones, skeletons, bats, spiders and worms.
